LEGENDARY BOK CAPTAIN BECOMES ASTRAL'S BRAND AMBASSADOR

Claassen is well known for his illustrious career in rugby which began in 1973, when he made his debut for the Blue Bulls. The culmination of his rugby career came when he led the Springbok rugby team as Captain between 1981 and 1982 in seven official test matches and 13 other games for South African sides. Between 1980 and 1984, Claassen also played 65 games for the (then) Natal province, all as Captain. In 1985 he became the youngest ever

National Springbok Selector also serving in this and other capacities for both the sevens and U/19 teams until 2004.

He is a qualified architect and owns his own architectural firm in Pretoria, where he still practices. In 1985 he published his autobiography, "More Than Just Rugby", which topped the best-seller's list in South Africa for three consecutive months and was reprinted in 1996 as "The Final Chapter". He recently published another autobiography about his youth, "Kaalvoetklong tot Rugbytoks" and served as Editor-in-Chief for "Rugby Weekly" and the "Sharks Magazine" during his career. Claassen, being the ultimate sportsman, has also completed 11 Comrades Marathons, the Duzi2C mountain bike race, three Cape Argus cycle races and two 94.7 cycle races.

"I'm honoured to be chosen as the Astral Brand Ambassador and look forward to represent and promote Astral's leading poultry and animal feed brands," confirmed Claassen.

Chris Schutte, CEO of Astral, said: "Wynand's appointment as the Brand Ambassador formalises a relationship that spans many years.
